Our Jerusalem Hill vineyard is our lowest elevation vineyard, and is located 18 miles south of the Dundee hills in the Eola-Amity Hills. This vineyard is planted in a Woodburn sedimentary soil brought into the valley during the Missoula Floods, 13,000 to 15,000 years ago.

On the palate, the wine is silky and well-balanced with concentrated, opulent flavors. This wine delivers a great balance between both richness and flavor-driven intensity, along with a wonderfully persistent finish.
